Principal Remarks: School Community Picnic - Wednesday May 31st, Rain Date June 7th, looking to make it as efficient as possible. Met with full staff already. Adjustments from prior years: everyone will be out there at the same time. Roughly 1-3, all subject to change. Run lunches for the students on a half day schedule during lunch time for the students only, working out details for cafeteria staff, tents set up by class and grade level, collect licenses, bring everyone through Raptor, each classroom/grade level there will be sides and picnic stuff pre-determined due to restrictions, cooler/ice/waters/snacks will be donated by parents in each grade level, range of activities (kickball, soccer, volleyball, playscape, rock painting, tattoos, etc.), around 2:30 ice cream for everybody, sign out to go home right from there, all the kids stuff will be in the building so at 3:00 kids can go in and get all their things, whole piece has been rebuilt and will be refined. Anticipating that parking will be an issue. Cost will be \$5 a family (try to get things donated)

Superintendent Report: Budget. In order to maintain what we have, we need 4.2% (unionized staff, contracts to meet, rising costs, etc.) original budget came in at 4.8%, BoE increased it by about 1% (\$500,000) to a 5.84% increase. New for Fiscal Year 20224: Career Pathways (\$100,000) New Positions, Mandated Training, Grant Staff, and ESS at McGee (\$110,000), lost some funding through Choice (not meeting the 4%, currently at 3.61%), Berlin ranks 60th in wealth but spends at 100th rank. Projected to have 45 fewer students overall K-12. 400 apartments will come online within the next year and a half.
